I have been practising in rural and regional Victoria for over 30 years I have just completed a 2 year contract working in remote Central Australia Desert communities. I want to stress very strongly that mandatory ongoing Supervision by another appropriately qualified and experienced Psychologist

is absolutely essential for safe practice for both client and psychologist especially in rural, regional and remote environments.

Also this is a totally different issue to PD requirements and serves a very different purpose. PD improves your skill and knowledge base, while supervision provides feedback and peer review of practise.
