I endorse the comments made about the draft national registration document by the College of Counselling Psychologists.

In addition, I expect that any psychologist who has been deemed qualified as a specialist psychologist under the Medicare Scheme is deemed qualified as a specialist under the proposed new national psychologist registration scheme. That is, given the qualifications of such psychologists have been deemed to be the equivalent of a Clinical Masters by the APS Medicare Assessment Team, they must also be deemed as equivalent to a Masters for the purposes of Specialist National Registration, as specified in the document under the grandparent clause.
